Residents of the City of Kingman are invited to dispose of unwanted large or bulky waste items during the Kingman Spring Clean-Up. Users must show a photo ID with proof of residency or proof of property ownership in the City of Kingman to use this service.

Go to the intersection of Sherman & Pine, then go south.
Follow the dirt road to the bulk waste dump area inside the fence.
Signs will guide you to where you need to go.

Items accepted: Tree limbs, brush, sofas, chairs, household furniture, televisions, ovens, dryers, washers, microwaves, hot water heaters, etc.

*Items **NOT** accepted:* Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, tires, shingles w/ asbestos, oil, batteries, pesticides, fertilizers, liquid waste of any kind, or any material considered hazardous waste.

Retail and Wholesale waste will not be accepted.

The City of Kingman and Waste Connections, Inc., reserve the right to limit or refuse acceptance of any material from any person(s) bringing items to the drop-off collection area.

SPECIAL NOTICE

City staff will not handle bulky waste that is being deposited. Residents will need to bring enough help to get their bulky waste into the dumpsters. City staff will be present to manage the site, but they will not unload items from any trailers or vehicles. We appreciate everyone's cooperation in this regard.
