ORDINANCE NO. 2097

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7-314 RELATING TO THE ENFORCEMENT OF FIREWORKS LAWS CONTAINED IN CHAPTER 7, ARTICLE 3, OF THE KINGMAN CITY CODE

WHEREAS, the Governing Body has determined that sections of the Kingman City Code relating to fireworks should be amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF KINGMAN, KANSAS:

Section 1. Section 7-314 of Kingman City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

“7-314. AUTHORITY OF FIRE CHIEF; AUTHORITY OF POLICE DEPARTMENT. The Chief of the Fire Department is authorized to seize and confiscate all fireworks that may be kept, stored, or used in violation of any section of this article, and all of the rules of the State Fire Marshal. He or she shall dispose of all such fireworks as may be directed by the governing body. Nothing in the article shall be construed as limiting the Kingman Police Department’s authority to enforce all ordinances and resolutions of the City.”

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage by the Governing Body and publication of a summary of the Ordinance in the official City newspaper with a copy of the original Ordinance posted on the city’s website.
