Information About Frequently Asked Topics

First, WELCOME to the City of Kingman – A Great Place To Land! To help your transition to our city, we have collected answers to some frequently asked questions. The City’s website, www.cityofkingman.com, is a great source of information about Kingman, but if you have other questions, feel free to ask personnel at City Hall.

Electric, Sewer, and Water: The City operates all three of these utilities. The City has its own electric generating plant, a wastewater treatment plant, and its own wells for water. Charges for the electric, sewer, and water services are on one combined bill and must be paid in full by the 10th of each month. The City’s payment policies will be provided to you when you start utility services. Payment may be made in person at City Hall, over the telephone, or online by going to www.cityofkingman.com and clicking on “Online Bill Pay”. If you have any problems related to the electric, sewer, or water during a regular business day, please call 532-3111 which is City Hall. If problems occur after office hours, during weekends, or holidays, please call 532-2131 or 532-3138. All basements or cellars with plumbing fixtures connected to the sanitary sewer line shall be provided with a back-water trap or gate valve. Property damage resulting from backup sewage is the homeowner’s responsibility.

Gas Service: Contact the Kansas Gas Service at 1-800-794-4780 (24-hour service).

Cable Television: Cox Cable Television. Call 1-800-234-3993.

Telephone: Local phone service is AT&T. Call 1-800-288-2020.

Garbage and/or Trash Pickup: Contact **Waste Connections** of Kansas, who has the City’s franchise for this service. Telephone 316-838-4920. They can inform you where to place your refuse, the type, number and size of containers allowed, the charge for this service and the day scheduled for pickup in your area.

Driver’s License Renewals/Exam Station: 2nd Floor, Kingman County Courthouse, 130 N. Spruce Street, Kingman, 532-5080. Check with that office for specific days and times of operation.

Voter Registration: A city resident 18 or older may register at City Hall or the Kingman County Courthouse.

Building Permits: No building on any structure shall commence before obtaining a building permit from the City Inspector. Also Electric, Plumbing, and Gas permits are needed. Contractors must be licensed by the City and present at the time of any inspection.

Pets: Do you have one? You must purchase a current dog/cat tag within 30 days after you move to the City of Kingman. A rabies certificate dated within the past year is required to purchase the tag. All dogs/cats must be confined in some manner and at no time allowed to run loose within the City limits. Some dogs are prohibited (as defined by City ordinance).

Burning Of Trash: Prohibited within the City of Kingman without a permit. You may secure a burning permit at the City Hall.

Internet Services: There are several companies that serve Kingman. Some of these companies are Cox, AT&T, Dish Network, and KanOkla. Please check with companies directly for pricing information.

General Public Transportation: The City operates a general public transportation system. Fares are \$1 per destination. The buses only operate within the city limits of Kingman. Riders are taken on a first-come, first-served basis. The transportation dispatch line to request a ride is 532-1130.
