PARKING LOT: Motion made by Hacker, seconded by Wallace table the Parking Lot Ordinance until more details get worked out. Motion declared carried by unanimous vote.

TOWNSHIPS: Motion made by Hacker, seconded by Wollen approve the White Township Fire Contract in the amount of \$14,700.00. Motion declared carried by unanimous vote.


Motion made by Hacker seconded by Wallace approve the Ninnescah Township Fire Contract in the amount of \$29,400.00. Motion declared carried by unanimous vote.

Motion made by Hacker, seconded by Wollen approve the Hoosier Township Fire Contract in the amount of \$14,700.00. Motion declared carried by unanimous vote.
