ORDINANCE NO. 2114

AN ORDINANCE CREATING SECTION 15-111(i) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF KINGMAN RELATED TO THE INITIATION OF UTILITY SERVICES BY CORPORATE ENTITIES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF KINGMAN, KANSAS:

Section 1. SECTION 15-111(i) shall be created as follows:

(i) Sub-section (c) of this Section shall not apply for utility service applications from a limited liability company or corporation of any type. Instead, limited liability companies and corporations must provide a valid certificate of good standing from the Kansas Secretary of State. Limited liability companies and corporations shall have a continuing duty to provide a current certificate of good standing when requested. Should the applicant limited liability company or corporation change ownership after utility services are initiated, it shall provide an updated certificate of good standing to the City for the changed, responsible entity.

<u>Section 2</u>. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage by the Governing Body and publication of a summary of the Ordinance in the official City newspaper with a copy of the original Ordinance posted on the City's website.
