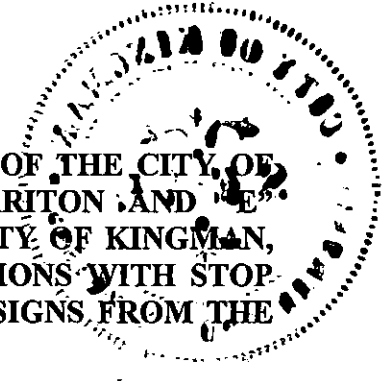

ORDINANCE NO. 2122

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 14-207 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF KINGMAN TO REMOVE YIELD INTERSECTIONS AT CHARITON AND "E" AVENUE AND CHARITON AND "F" AVENUE WITHIN THE CITY OF KINGMAN, KANSAS, TO REPLACE THE YIELD SIGNS AT SAME LOCATIONS WITH STOP SIGNS, AND TO REMOVE WASHINGTON AND PINE YIELDS SIGNS FROM THE ORDINANCE AS THEY WERE REPLACED WITH STOP SIGNS.



BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF KINGMAN, KANSAS:

Section 1: Section 14-207 of the Code of the City of Kingman shall be amended to read as follows:

**“14-207. YIELD INTERSECTIONS.** The following intersections not on through streets are designated as yield intersections; and when signs are erected at one or more entrances, as stated, the drivers of the vehicles shall yield before entering the intersection.

- Avenue “G” and Marquette Street intersection
- Chariton and “A” yield signs north and south
- Chariton and “B” Yield Signs North and South
- Coronado and “C” Avenue yield signs north and south
- Coronado and “F” Avenue yield signs north and south
- Douglas and “A” yield signs north and south
- Douglas and “F” Avenue yield sign east
- Elm and “H” yield signs east and west
- Grove and 8th yield sign south
- Grant and Pine yield signs north and south
- Northeast corner of Washington Avenue and Sugar Street to stop vehicles from traveling west before entering Sugar Street
- Pine and “A” yield signs north and south
- Poplar and 8th yield sign south
- Sugar and Washington no yield sign at all
- Veach and Logan yield signs east and west”


Section 2: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage by the Governing Body, approval by the Mayor and publication of the Ordinance or a summary thereof in the official City newspaper.
