

Content Policy for City of Kingman Social Media Sites

The City of Kingman social media sites exist to provide citizens and stakeholders with information about City of Kingman programs and services. The social media and websites of the City of Kingman are not general information sites, but rather specifically geared to the City of Kingman itself and its needs as the governing body of Kingman. The City of Kingman's social media sites are monitored regularly. **Emergency information should be reported to 9-1-1. Requests for services should be made directly to City Hall at (620) 532-3111.**

The City of Kingman encourages healthy discussion and varying viewpoints about issues affecting residents and stakeholders. However, the City of Kingman social media sites will not feature, allow, and will remove:

- Language or information that is obscene, foul, or vulgar.
- Information affiliated with or promoting political campaigns.
- Promotion or endorsement of tobacco, alcohol, or similar products or information.
- Hostility or violence.
- Illegal discrimination or attacks against any person or group.
- Illegal activity.
- Online gaming, gambling, or betting.
- The advertising or offering of products and/or services for sale, other than those being offered by the City of Kingman.
- Solicitations for donations, except for official City-sponsored activities.
- Promotion of events or activities that are not City-sponsored.
- Personal or sensitive information (social security numbers, credit card numbers, account numbers, banking information, phone numbers, email addresses, postal addresses, and similar materials).
- Repeat offenders may be banned from City social media sites.

The City of Kingman may make exceptions to the stated restrictions if doing so is deemed, at the sole discretion of the City, to be in the best interest of the City, its residents, and/or other stakeholders.

Any post containing such material may be deleted at the sole discretion of the City of Kingman. If you see any material or information posted to or by the City of Kingman that is inconsistent with the list of prohibited materials, please notify City Hall at (620) 532-3111.

The City of Kingman reserves the right, but undertakes no duty, in its sole discretion, to review, edit, move, or delete any material submitted as a comment to the information provided for display or placed on the social media websites without notice. Comments submitted to these sites will be reviewed and inappropriate comments may be deleted at the sole discretion of the City of Kingman.
